## Enhancing Mentorship in Scientific Research: Mentoring Workshops for STEM Mentors on Experimental Research, Instrumentation, Ethical Considerations and Research Program Management

To:

Schools Division Superintendents Division Science and Math Supervisors Public Secondary School Heads of Science-Implementing Schools All Others Concerned

1. This Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will conduct a series of mentoring activities for STEM research advisers and division science and math supervisors on the following dates at a venue to be announced later:

- June 26–28, 2025 Mentoring the Mentors of Student Researchers: Workshop on Scientific Investigations and Innovation Expos
- July 10-11, 2025 Mentoring the Mentors of Student Research Mentors: Workshop and Orientation for Division STEM Fair Project Leaders

2. The mentoring sessions aim to enhance the competencies of research advisers and division project leaders in effectively guiding students through the scientific research process. Topics include designing and conducting investigations, using appropriate instrumentation, observing research standards and ethical practices, understanding intellectual property rights, and applying scientific review and screening guidelines.

3. The participants for the first mentoring workshop are the research advisers or coaches from STE/STEM schools who require technical support in conducting experimental research. Division Science Supervisors are requested to nominate participants based on the allocated slots per division by completing the Google Sheet—which includes required credentials—that will be sent to them on or before **May 30, 2025**.
