**CONDUCT OF SCHOOL – BASED DEWORMING IN SDO  
SORSOGON**

**TO:** Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

1. This Office through the School Governance Operation Division – Health and Nutrition Section informs the conduct of School Based Deworming in compliance with the DepEd Memorandum OM-OUOPS-2025, School Based Deworming to be conducted in all Public Elementary & Secondary Schools on July 9, 2025 for the 1<sup>st</sup> dosage.
2. This aims to treat and prevent soil transmitted helminthiasis infections that have detrimental impact on children's growth and development. The Guidelines on mass deworming administration (MDA) stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No. 80 s. 2025 must be observed by DepEd and DOH personnel, no children will be dewormed without parents' permit. The school nurses assigned in the district will coordinate and conduct orientation with the local health unit to ensure adequate technical support and the provision of deworming medicines.
3. The schools are enjoined to promote the deworming program, through advocacy & producing of parents' permit. RHU personnel, Barangay Health Workers will be assisted by the School Health Section personnel to dispense, give assistance and administer proper management of any severe adverse event following deworming (SAEFD).



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4. Non-medical school staff are **not allowed** to administer deworming medication to prevent error and untoward incident in the implementation of the program.
5. Enclosed in this memorandum is the template of the deworming master list, consent and consolidated accomplishment report to be accomplished & submitted by school under the supervision of the school heads to the school health section. 6. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be chargeable against school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules & regulations.

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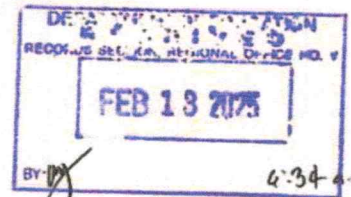

The Department of Education, through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) hereby issues this Advisory on the School-Based Deworming Program.

The resumption of the School-Based Deworming Program is hereby advised pending the signing of the Joint Administrative Order (JAO) on Health Services between and among the Departments of Education, Health and Interior and Local Government

While awaiting the approval of the JAO on Health Services, the following Interim Guidelines for Implementation shall be observed to ensure the safety and effectiveness of the activity:

- Schools will coordinate with local health units to ensure adequate technical support and the provision of deworming medicines;
- Written consent from parents or guardians must be obtained before administering deworming medicines;
- All personnel involved must adhere to prescribed health and safety protocols;
- Conduct of orientation sessions for school staff, parents, and learners to address concerns and provide accurate information;
- School Heads are required to monitor and promptly report any adverse reactions to deworming medicines to local health units for immediate action;

- f. Deworming activities should be integrated into broader health education initiatives to highlight their benefits and importance; and
- g. Implementation schedules should be arranged in collaboration with school authorities, local health units and communicated clearly.

**GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL  
SCHOOL DEWORMING DAY (NSDD)**

1. The Department of Health (DOH), in partnership with the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Health and Nutrition Center (HNC), will conduct the **National School Deworming Day (NSDD)** on July 29, 2015.
2. The NSDD aims to deworm approximately 16 million school-aged children enroled in all public elementary schools in one day, to reduce the burden of Soil Transmitted Helminthiasis (STH) infections with a positive impact on children's education and health.
3. In support of this nationwide activity, the DepEd hereby issues the enclosed **Guidelines on the Implementation of the NSDD**.
4. All regional directors, schools division superintendents and school heads are encouraged to ensure the successful implementation of this activity. The DepEd and DOH health personnel and local government units (LGUs) will join efforts to achieve NSDD's goal.
