**SUBMISSION OF DATA ON THE NUMBER OF GRADE 4 TEACHERS
AND LEARNERS FOR THE CHA-CHING PROGRAM**

1. The Cha-Ching Program developed by Junior Achievement of the Philippines, Inc. (JA Philippines) in partnership with Prudence Foundation and Pru Life UK conducted an online training last September 18, 2025 from 1:00 p.m to 4:00 p.m through the Zoom Platform.
2. The objectives of the training are as follows:
 - a. Orient teachers on the Cha-Ching Curriculum specifically designed for Grade 4 students;
 - b. Equip teachers with tools and strategies for effectively delivering lessons on Earn, Save, Spend, and Donate;
 - c. Provide a walkthrough of the Teacher's Guide and Student Kit; and
 - d. Prepare teachers for the implementation timeline and integration into their instruction.

No personally identifiable information (e.g., learner names, addresses, or other unique identifiers) shall be included. Only aggregate data of Grade 4 learners and teachers shall be reported.

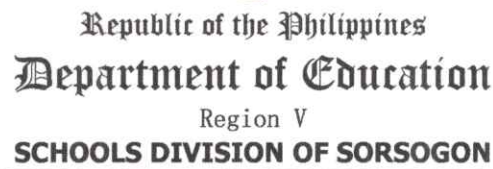
