# CHECK-IN ASSESSMENT TOOLS FOR THE ACADEMIC RECOVERY AND ACCESSIBLE LEARNING (ARAL) PROGRAM

- 1. This is in reference to DM-OULS-2025-2026-166 concerning the mandated administration of check-in assessments for Key Stages (KS) 1 to 3 under the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program. These assessments are essential for the systematic monitoring of learners' progress, ensuring full compliance with Republic Act No. 12028, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, DepEd Order No. 18, s. 2025, and DepEd Memorandum No. 64, s. 2025.
- 2. Consistent with the governing policies, progress checks shall be administered following the specific frequency and utilizing the assessment tools presented in the table below:
