Pursuant to Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01, series of 2026 and Commission En Banc Resolution No. R002-A – 2026, which establish the policies and guidelines for the Bagong Pilipinas Merit Scholarship Program (BPMSP), the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) announces the opening of twenty thousand (20,000) BPMSP scholarship slots for incoming first-year college students enrolling in identified priority programs for the First Semester of Academic Year (AY) 2026–2027.

Interested applicants may submit their applications, together with scanned copies of the documentary requirements, through the official BPMSP application portal at <https://bpms.ched.gov.ph> from 30 April 2026 until 30 June 2026 or until slots are available.

CHED Regional Offices (CHEDROs) are hereby advised to take note of and ensure proper dissemination of the following program components:

I. Eligibility Requirements

- a. Filipino Citizen;
- b. Incoming first year college student
- c. Belongs to the Top Five (5) of the graduating class OR with a minimum General Weighted Average (GWA) of 95% (or its equivalent) in Grade 12;
- d. Has not earned any units or degree in tertiary education;
- e. Has parents or legal guardians with a combined annual gross income not exceeding Two Million Pesos (PhP 2,000,000);
- f. Enrolled in CHED-identified priority programs (Full list of priority programs and identified Delivering Higher Education Institutions (DHEIs) can be accessed here: <https://bpms.ched.gov.ph/priority-lists>)

II. Documentary Requirements

- a. Accomplished application form through the official BPMS online application portal;
- b. Copy of Birth Certificate issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA);
- c. Certified True Copy (CTC) of the Learner's Progress Report Card or School Form 9 (SF9) [Form 138], duly signed by the registrar or an authorized representative of the senior high school attended;
- d. Certified True Copy (CTC) of a certificate issued by the Senior High School attended certifying that the applicant belongs to the Top Five (5) of the graduating class, duly signed by the school head, registrar, or an authorized representative, if applicable;
- e. Any one (1) of the following documents as proof of income:
 - i. Certificate of Tax Exemption/Non-Filer issued by the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR); or
 - ii. Certificate from the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) or City/Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (C/MSWD) for Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) beneficiaries; or
 - iii. Latest Annual Income Tax Return (BIR Form No. 1701) or Certificate of Compensation Payment/Tax Withheld (BIR Form No. 2316) of both parents or legal guardians or of the applicant; or
 - iv. Certified True Copy (CTC) of the latest contract or proof of income for children of Overseas Filipino Workers (OFW) and Seafarers; and
- f. Copy of university/college admission slip or proof of admission to the degree program
- g. Duly filled and signed Parent/Legal Guardian Consent Form attached as Annex L (For applicants below 18 years old)
- h. *For applicants who graduated under the basic education curriculum of DepEd on or before School Year 2015–2016: Certified True Copy (CTC) of the Fourth Year Report Card (Form 138) issued by the last high school attended, in lieu of the document required under item c.*
- i. Additional documentary proof may be required if the applicant belongs to a Special Equity Group (i.e. PWD, Solo Parent, IP, etc.)




Further, CHEDROs are directed to undertake the following:

1. Submit the official ranklist/masterlist of qualified applicants within forty-five (45) days after the evaluation period;
2. Ensure full utilization of allocated scholarship slots and immediately inform the Office of Student Development and Services (OSDS) of any unutilized slots for appropriate action.

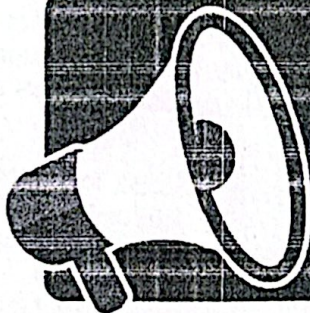

- 3. From households with annual gross income of parents or guardians ranging from Php 0 To Php 2,000,000
- 4. Must enroll in priority programs identified by CHED
- 5. Must accept and render mandatory return service in the country


